### Chapter 1 — The Shock of Being Left Behind

The trumpet has sounded. The dead in Christ have risen. The faithful have been caught up. But you remain.

The first reaction of those left behind will be shock — an overwhelming flood of fear, regret, and confusion. Questions will haunt the mind: Why wasn't I taken? Did I miss something? What do I do now?

Jesus warned of this very moment:

"And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut. Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not." — Matthew 25:10–12 The door of the rapture is now closed. The Bride has entered, but you are outside.

The days ahead will be filled with persecution and fear. Jesus foretold:

"Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake." — Matthew 24:9

The shock of being left behind must give way to repentance. Fall to your knees. Cry out to Jesus.

He is still merciful.

# Chapter 2 — The Tribulation According to the Bible You are now entering the most dreadful period in human history: the seven-year tribulation. This time is

clearly outlined in the Word:

"And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one

week; and in the midst of the week he shall cause the

sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate."—

Daniel 9:27

The tribulation begins with a deceptive peace and

ends with catastrophic judgments. Revelation

describes it in detail:

Seals (Revelation 6): war, famine, pestilence, death.

Trumpets (Revelation 8–9): ecological disasters, demonic plagues.

Bowls (Revelation 16): the final outpouring of God's wrath.

Jesus Himself said:
"For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not

since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be." — Matthew 24:21

The tribulation is not mere suffering — it is divine

judgment on a rebellious world. Yet in this judgment, many will turn to Christ. You can be among them.

## Chapter 3 — The Rise of the Antichrist and Global Control

The confusion of the rapture will give rise to a global leader — the Bible calls him the Antichrist. He will appear as a man of peace, but his power is rooted in deception.

#### Daniel prophesied:

"And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up. And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people." —

Daniel 8:23-24

John saw him as the beast:

"And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: and that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six."

— Revelation 13:16–18

This mark of the beast will be the system of global control. To accept it means eternal damnation. To refuse it means persecution, hunger, and possible death — but eternal life.

## Chapter 4 — How to Survive Spiritually During Tribulation

Physical survival will be difficult, but spiritual survival is essential. Jesus said:
"But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall

be saved." — Matthew 24:13
Survival Guidelines:

Repent and Pray Constantly. Call upon Jesus for mercy.

Cling to the Scriptures. Memorize verses; Bibles may become scarce.

Avoid the Mark. Do not sell your soul for temporary

comfort.

Fellowship Secretly. Encourage other believers; you

will need each other.

Be Ready for Martyrdom. Death in Christ is victory,

not defeat.

The saints will overcome not by strength, but by faith:

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death." — Revelation 12:11

## Chapter 5 — The Cost of Following Christ in Those Days

Following Christ in the tribulation will cost you everything — but will reward you eternally.

Jesus warned:

"And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved." —

Matthew 10:22

Many will pay with their lives:

"And I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years." — Revelation 20:4

Yet the suffering is temporary compared to eternal glory:

"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." — Romans 8:18

#### Closing Appeal — It's Not Too Late

If you are reading this, hope remains. Do not harden your heart. Cry out to Jesus now. He still saves.

"Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man." — Luke 21:36

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise...
but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any
should perish, but that all should come to
repentance." — 2 Peter 3:9

The rapture has passed. The tribulation has begun. The Antichrist will soon rise. But your soul can still be saved. Choose Christ. Refuse the mark. Endure to the end.

### How to get saved The Bible Way

#### The ABC's of Salvation....

- (A). Recognize and admit that you are lost as a sinner
- (B). Believe that Jesus died for all of your sins. *Read* 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
- (C) Repent by turning to Jesus as your savior by believing the Gospel
  Put your faith alone, and not your works or qualification on what Jesus did for you on the cross.
  - (D). Say it to God that you believe that Jesus died for your sins and raised Him from the dead for your justification, and you are done.

... if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9

You are now saved, sanctified, and sealed unto the day of redemption..

"For it is by grace you are saved through faith. It is not your own doing. It is the FREE gift of God. Not by works lest any man boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

(E). Join a true Bible believing fellowship where you can grow.
